



## **SCHEDULE 2 Details of the Processing**

### **Nature and Purpose of Processing**

Minsh will Process Personal Data as necessary to perform the Services pursuant to the Agreement, as further specified in the Documentation, and as further instructed by Customer in its use of the Services.

### **Duration of Processing**

Subject to Clause 8 of the DPA, Minsh will Process Personal Data for the duration of the Agreement, unless otherwise agreed upon in writing.

### **Categories of Data Subjects**

Customer may submit Personal Data to the Services, the extent of which is determined and controlled by Customer in its sole discretion, and which may include, but is not limited to Personal Data relating to the following categories of data subjects:

- Customers, business partners, vendors and subcontractors of Customer (who are natural persons)
- Employees or contact persons of Customer's customers, business partners, vendors and subcontractors
- Employees, agents, advisors, contractors, and freelancers of Customer (who are natural persons)
- Customer's Users authorized by Customer to use the Services

### **Type of Personal Data**

Customer may submit Personal Data to the Services, the extent of which is determined and controlled by Customer in its sole discretion, and which may include, but is not limited to the following categories of Personal Data:

- Email address
- Identification and contact data (first and last name, phone number, business address)
- IP address
- General location data derived from IP address (e.g., country or region)
- Payment-related information (processed by third-party payment providers)
- Connection and usage data
- Device or language preferences

**Sensitive Data**

The Services are not designed for the processing of special categories of Personal Data (within the meaning of Article 9 of the EU GDPR) or Personal Data relating to criminal convictions and offences (within the meaning of Article 10 of the EU GDPR), and Minsh does not require such data to provide the Services. Customer remains solely responsible for any decision to submit such data through the Services and for ensuring an appropriate lawful basis and any required additional safeguards.

**Frequency of the Transfer**

Continuous, for the duration of the Agreement.

**Automated Decision-Making**

Minsh does not use Personal Data for automated decision-making producing legal or similarly significant effects on Data Subjects within the meaning of Article 22 of the EU GDPR.

**Children's Personal Data**

The Services are not directed at children under the age of 16, and Minsh does not knowingly process Personal Data of children under that age. Customer is responsible for ensuring that the Services are not used to collect Personal Data from children where such collection would be unlawful.

**Technical and Organizational Measures**

The technical and organizational measures applied by Minsh to protect Customer Data are set out in Clause 6.1 of the DPA.
